ACCIDENT DESCRIPTION

On Sunday, he was finishing his shift emptying municipal trash barrels in the downtown area and had driven his trash truck back to the city's yard at District Road off outer Congress Street. About 10 a.m., Dinh got out of the city-owned truck and was then somehow killed by it. A resident discovered Dinh about 1 p.m., the city said.

Gerickont was driving a garbage truck north on Route 5, police said, when he drove off the right side of the road, rolling the truck on its side and striking a tree.

Ryan Leeman, 39, of Bangor was on Oak Street about 2:15 p.m. when he was struck and killed, according to William Birch, deputy chief of the Penobscot County Sheriff's Office.
